Language: The language of the conference will be English.

Guidelines of Abstract Submission:

1. Abstract should be written in English.
2. Abstract should only contain 250 words at the maximum.
3. Please complete the on-line abstract submission form on or before April 23, 2010. Failure to do so may result to non-acceptance of paper. Click here for [submission](#).
4. Papers must not have been presented or published elsewhere. This can be on-going or completed research. We discourage multiple authorship.
5. The abstract will be reviewed by the abstract review committee. Results will be posted at the conference website. The organizers will only inform the accepted applicants by email. Enquiries related to non-acceptance of papers will not be entertained.
6. Final paper submission is due on May 14, 2010 with a maximum of 10 pages, 12-pt, Times New Roman, single space in MSWord format. Name your file using your family name (CAPITALIZED), first name, and abstract (e.g. GALASJanabstract.doc) and send to sogangugradresearchcon@yahoo.com.
